### BRIEF MBA ADVISEMENT

- complete foundations, then take ACCT 6130\* in your first semester**
- take ECON 6200, BA or QMBE 6780, MANG 6401**
- take FIN 6300, MANG 6476, and MKT 6503.**
- Please sign up to graduate at least two semesters before you wish to graduate.** Your file will be audited, then you'll need to sign your graduation papers in the MBA Office. **YOU MAY NOT ENROLL YOURSELF IN MANG 6480, and this should be the last course you take in the MBA Program.**

#### **CONCENTRATIONS:**

**As long as you have met the prerequisites, you may begin your concentration electives.**

**FINANCE** ( take ACCT 6130\* and ECON 6200 before enrolling in FIN 6300 then start FIN electives)

**MARKETING:** (take ACCT 6130\*, ECON 6200, before enrolling in MKT 6503; then start MKT elective)

**FOR OTHER CONCENTRATIONS:** Notice that some concentration courses are available in specific semesters. ***Concentration courses CANNOT be guaranteed for the SUMMER semesters, and are usually offered in the FALL and SPRING semesters only.***

MORE THAN ONE CONCENTRATION MAY BE OBTAINED IN THE MBA PROGRAM.

\*(If you have an Accounting Undergraduate Degree, you must choose another ACCT 6000-level course to replace ACCT 6130. Some choices are: ACCT 6125, ACCT 6133, ACCT 6143 (**if obtaining an MIS concentration, the ACCT 6143 may count as alternate to ACCT 6130, but you must then take the remaining MANG 6451, MANG 6452, MANG 6453, MANG 6454 or two of the MIS courses and one approved elective**)). Accounting Auditing course alternatives requires 3.0 GPA and 450 GMAT and must be pre-approved by the Accounting Department before enrolling in these courses.
